About the Program

If you are a psychotherapist—or have an academic interest in psychoanalytic psychotherapy—and you want to learn more about the theories that started it all, then this introductory program has been designed for you. It is a twenty-four-week course, offered one evening per week for two hours, that combines the teaching of basic concepts of psychoanalytic psychotherapy with explanatory clinical examples. The current status of this theoretical approach will also be described. Knowledge and understanding of concepts such as transference and counter-transference can be of enormous help in making sense of interactions with patients and clients, no matter what your preferred modality of treatment or, indeed, your profession.

This unique program is offered by the Toronto Psychoanalytic Society in response to the growing interest of individuals who want more than their clinical education has offered to date, or to people who have developed an interest in this field. This is not a training program; however, it provides an excellent introduction to the core concepts. Seminars are taught by experienced psychoanalysts,

and are held on Thursday evenings, from 7:30 to 9:30 pm, from September to April.

Admission and Fees

This program is open to mental health professionals and other professionals who are interested in learning about the ideas and theories of psychoanalytic therapy. The educational requirement is a master's degree or other professional degree. Previous clinical experience is always an asset. Personal therapy can also be helpful. All applicants will be interviewed by a member of the Committee.
